Each blossom releases a light, refreshing fragrance and its medium green foliage is lush and semi-glossy. Mother of Pearl® boasts good health and disease resistance and is particularly robust against black spot.</p>

	Sunny Sky (HT) Sunny Sky amazes with her apricot buds opening into large, elegantly shaped petals in honey yellow. Her rare-colored blooms emit a fruity fragrance and sit on sturdy stems, making them a great cut rose. She is a prolific producer of medium, double (17-25 petals) blooms.

She is a vigorous, continual blooming bush with mahogany new foliage maturing to deep green. An All-American Award Winner, an excellent cut rose, and a color to die for.
	True Passion (HT) With its blazing, double, ruffled, fire-orange blooms backed by Kelly-green foliage, this highly disease resistant hybrid tea rose flowers from June until the first heavy frost of autumn. 	<p>Elizabeth</p> <p>A majestic rose bearing clusters of large, crisp apple blossom pink rosettes, paling to the gentlest blush white. She has a strong, sweet, fresh fragrance with hints of lemon sherbet and Old Rose. Exceptionally healthy and versatile of habit, she forms a shapely and commanding shrub.</p>
	<p>Emily Bronte</p> <p>An exceptionally beautiful rose; the distinctive blooms are very neat and rather flat. Each bloom is a lovely soft pink, with a subtle apricot hue, the smaller central petals deepening to rich apricot and surrounding a button eye, which unfurls to reveal deep-set stamens. The strong Tea fragrance becomes more Old Rose, with delicious hints of lemon and grapefruit. It forms a bushy shrub with strong, healthy, upright growth.</p>
	<p>Gabriel Oak</p> <p>A magnificent variety, bearing large, many petalled rosette blooms. They are a striking shade of deep pink, the outer petals of each bloom paling slightly over time. The beauty of the blooms is enhanced by a wonderful, strong fruity fragrance. A vigorous rose; it forms a very shapely, broad, rounded shrub with mulberry purple stems and dark green foliage, giving the overall impression of richness and abundance. Named after the beloved character in Thomas Hardy's novel, Far from the Madding Crowd.</p>
	<p>Golden Celebration</p> <p>Magnificent, cupped, golden yellow blooms. Delicious tea scent with hints of Sauternes wine and strawberry. An award-winning variety: in every way an excellent garden plant.</p>
	<p>Hyde Hall</p> <p>A very large shrub, producing mid pink, rosette blooms in both small and large sprays. The individual blooms have a simple beauty but are particularly impressive when viewed en masse. The foliage is fine and pointed, similar to that of a Wild Rose. It is very tough, reliable and healthy. Named after the Royal Horticultural Society's Essex estate, which includes many English Roses.</p>
	<p>Jubilee Celebration</p> <p>Large, domed, coral-pink flowers are held elegantly above the foliage on graceful, arching growth. There is a strong, delicious fruity fragrance with hints of fresh lemon and raspberry.</p>

ENGLISH ROSES BY DAVID AUSTIN	
	<p>Lady of Shalott (CL) Rich orange-red buds open to chalice-shaped blooms, filled with loosely arranged, orange petals. The surrounding outer petals are salmon-pink with beautifully contrasting golden-yellow undersides. There is a pleasant, warm Tea fragrance, with hints of spiced apple and cloves. It quickly forms a bushy shrub with slightly arching stems and mid-green leaves, which have attractive, slightly bronzed tones when young.</p>
	<p>Lichfield Angel Pale peachy pink buds gradually open to form neatly cupped, cream rosettes. Each bloom has a perfect ring of waxy petals enclosing numerous smaller petals. Eventually the petals turn back to form a large, domed flower. It forms a vigorous, rounded, almost thornless shrub, its blooms nodding attractively on the branch.</p>
	<p>Munstead Wood Light crimson buds gradually open to reveal very deep velvety crimson blooms. The flowers are large cups at first, becoming shallowly cupped with time. There is a strong Old Rose fragrance with warm, fruity notes of blackberry, blueberry, and damson. The bushy, spreading growth forms a broad shrub. Ideal for container or border.</p>
	<p>Nye Bevan An uplifting rose bearing unusual open cupped flowers of soft yellow, paling to cream. The scallop-shaped, incurved petals are loosely yet generously assembled around a central boss of golden stamens, creating a soft, airy appearance. There is a spectacular first flush of blooms, which are borne in well-spaced sprays and displayed proudly against the mid-green, semi-glossy foliage. Forms a healthy, medium-sized upright bush with a light myrrh fragrance, whose hips must be removed to encourage repeat flowering.</p>
	<p>Olivia Rose Austin Bears beautiful, cupped, mid pink rosettes, with a delicate fruity fragrance. It commences flowering exceptionally early in the season and flowers in flushes until well into the fall. It forms a very healthy, well-balanced shrub with dark green foliage, which shows off the flowers to the very best effect.</p>
	<p>Port Sunlight Medium-sized, flat, quartered rosettes of rich apricot, paling towards the edges. They have a lovely Tea fragrance. A vigorous, rather upright shrub; the foliage and young stems are a beautiful bronzy-red at first, becoming dark green over time. Named after the model village in the Wirral where there is a beautiful garden of English Roses.</p>

ENGLISH ROSES BY DAVID AUSTIN		
		<p>Princess Alexandra of Kent</p> <p>The unusually large, bright pink flowers are full-petalled and deeply cupped. In spite of their size, they are never clumsy, being held nicely poised on a well-rounded shrub. There is a strong and delicious fresh Tea fragrance, which changes to lemon, eventually taking on hints of blackcurrants.</p>
		<p>Silas Marner</p> <p>An unfussy rose of soft mid pink, the petals are pale on the reverse and fade at the edges creating a gentle quality. Held on red stems, the medium-sized cupped blooms have relaxed, almost ruffled petals which are set around an attractive button eye. There is a medium-strong Old Rose fragrance with accents of fruity lemon, green banana and apricot. A very healthy medium-sized shrub with glossy dark green foliage and wide, arching growth. Named after the kindhearted hero of George Eliot's classic novel.</p>
		<p>The Ancient Mariner</p> <p>Large and extremely floriferous, creating a dramatic display. An impressive variety, bearing masses of very large blooms almost continually from June until the first frosts.</p>
		<p>The Generous Gardener (CL)</p> <p>Bears beautifully formed flowers, which nod gracefully on the stem. When the petals open they expose numerous stamens, providing an almost water lily-like effect. The flowers are a pale glowing pink and have a delicious fragrance with aspects of Old Rose, musk and myrrh.</p>
		<p>The Poet's Wife</p> <p>Bears rich yellow flowers, which pale over time. Their formation is most pleasing, having a neat outer ring of petals enclosing an informal group of petals within. There is a strong, wonderfully rich fragrance with a hint of lemon, which becomes sweeter and stronger with age. It forms a bushy, nicely rounded shrub with arching branches and rather shiny foliage.</p>
		<p>Thomas á Becket</p> <p>A rose of similar character to the Species Roses, with natural, shrubby growth. The informal rosette flowers are a striking crimson-red. Held in medium-large sized heads, they nod attractively on their stems. The Old Rose fragrance has a distinct lemon zest character.</p>
		<p>Tranquility</p> <p>Very floriferous and notable for the perfection of its flowers</p> <p>An attractive, very floriferous variety, bearing pure white, beautifully rounded, rosette blooms. Almost thornless with very healthy, vigorous growth. Light apple fragrance.</p>

	<p>Vanessa Bell Large clusters of very free-flowering, pale yellow blooms Pink-tinged buds open to medium-sized cups held in large clusters. Pale yellow, paling to white at the edges; each with a rich yellow eye. The fragrance is similar to green Tea with aspects of lemon and honey. It forms a bushy, upright shrub.</p>
	<p>Windermere The blooms start as perfectly rounded buds, opening to full, cupped flowers that are rich creamy yellow at first, fading to almost pure white in the sun. They have a delicious fruity fragrance that has a definite hint of citrus. Very healthy; it forms a neat, compact plant, even in warmer areas.</p>
	<p>Young Lycidas Large, deeply cupped flowers, blending deep pink, magenta and red – the outer petals tending towards light purple, with an almost silvery quality. There is a delicious Tea and Old Rose scent, with hints of cedar wood. It makes an attractive, bushy shrub. Named after John Milton's poem, Lycidas.</p>
CLIMBERS	
	<p>Above and Beyond A hardy climber that produces clusters of large, light apricot, semi-double to double blooms with a mild, spice fragrance; presents a spring or summer flush, with scattered later bloom; may be grown as a shrub, or trained on garden walls and trellises.</p>
	<p>Cherry Frost Cherry Frost™ is a solid, cane hardy, zone 4 rose with beautiful clusters of smaller red blooms. Climbing rose of superior disease resistance. From spring until frost, she puts on a stunning display with flushes of small, beautiful clusters of cherry red blooms. You will not be disappointed by this distinguishable red, super bloomer!</p>
	<p>Florentina This moderate sized climber produces large clusters of clear red blooms that have a wonderful old fashioned, cupped appearance and a slight scent. Good repeat flowering with soft, easy trainable canes that have very few thorns. The shiny foliage is extremely disease resistant and tolerant of heat. A beautiful addition to the 'Climbing Max' collection from Kordes. Approx. 2.5m tall.</p>
